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TRACER Ridership: A year to date comparison of current ridership compared to the same period in the previous year is shown below. Fixed route ridership is down 61,879 riders compared to year to date ridership in April FY19/20, an decrease of approximately 58% Paratransit ridership is down 10,624 riders compared to the same time in FY19/20, a decrease of approximately 60%. Overall the Tracer system ridership has decreased 72,503 riders over the same period last year, an overall decrease of approximately 59%
