TRACER Ridership: A year to date comparison of current ridership compared to the same period in the previous year is shown below. Fixed route ridership is up 2,717 riders compared to year to date ridership in August FY20/21, an increase of approximately 30%. Paratransit ridership is up 160 riders compared to the same time in August FY20/21, an increase of approximately 10%. Overall the Tracer system ridership has increased 2,877 riders over the same period last year, an overall increase of approximately 28%
