Dear Mr. Adams,

Please note that per the Resolution of Formation for Community Facilities District 2021-2 Section 7. Special Tax c. the resolution states in part: "Territory in the Future Annexation Area will be annexed into the CFD, and a special tax will be levied on such territory only with the Unanimous Approval of the owner or owners of each parcel or parcels at the time that parcel or those parcels are annexed into the CFD."

We understand and have been told that if our property and others are included in the Future Annexation Area for the formation of this CFD, as property owners we are not compelled to annex into this CFD, but only if we voluntarily do so with our unanimous approval.

In light of this understanding of the Resolution we will not comment on this item as it has no effect on our property.
