Meetings

- San Joaquin Council of Governments
 - AB361 Meeting for continuance of virtually attended meetings
 - Board Meeting – Many updates like DIBS, Regional Housing Planning Process and the Plan Schedule 2022-2023. See Agenda.
- Mega Region Transportation Meeting
 - Focus shifted from 2021 of choosing the Dozen Projects (Tracy remains on the highlighted Dozen projects the combined transportation entities)
 - Shift to focus on funding. Evaluated Stakeholder Recommendation for MegaRegion Planners...Develop an affordable housing strategy for the megaregion, invest in infrastructure that acknowledges where population growth is happening, especially public and active transportation.
 - Received detailed stats on housing, jobs, current covid world, and other factors that affect transportation, ridership.
 - Dialogue regarding shared and overlapped markets.
- San Joaquin Regional Rail Commission (ACE)
 - Approved amendments and project. See agenda. Highlight: Approve a Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the San Joaquin Regional Rail Commission Approving the ACE 10 Ride Pilot Program. After staff gave detailed presentation on current ridership trends and behaviors, they introduced a pilot program that gives an option for 10 tickets versus 20 to give people a comfort level to begin riding more frequently. Part of the reduction is due to people being able to work part time from home.
- Tracy Unified School District Stem Collaborative Meeting
 - The challenge is how to get STEM access and exposure to all TUSD students. The combined group of TUSD and varied community partners began to brainstorm ways to carry out the plans they have including getting volunteers from the targeted industries to connect with the students. Need to build list of resources.
- South San Joaquin County Fire Authority (JPA)
 - Special Board Meeting
 - Regular Meeting focused on Midyear budget update. Suggested budget augmentations prior to budget meetings. See agenda for details. Noted new website.
- San Joaquin Partnerships – Attended meetings to build on the synergies and compiled resources within the partnership. Along with Tracy Econ Dev Dir Michael Nimon, we continue to pursue VOLT opportunity and others presented by the partnership.

Special Events

- Tracy African American Association (01/08/2022)
 - As mayor, swore in new officers for 2022-24 and later presented certificates to incoming officers. Councilmembers Dan Arriola and Eleassia Davis were in attendance to give congratulations. Tracy Police Chief Sekou Millington also presented awards and solidified the TPD commitment to partner with sub communities within the Tracy community.
- Tracy Chamber of Commerce Ribbon Cutting for Integrity Kutz N Stylez Barbershop (1/13/22). Glad to see Chief Sekou Millington and a number of Tracy Police Officers, including ED Director Michael Nimon out supporting local businesses.
- Celebration of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (01/17/2022)
 - From the vision of Audrey Harrison, West High Black Student Union (BSU) Advisor; TUSD Black Student Unions (West, Tracy, and Kimball HS), Empowered Youth, along with nonprofits such as Tracy African American Association, Chest of Hope, Empowered Youth, New Creations Church, and many volunteers made it a successful day of action for the homeless community. Many volunteers from nonprofits, including Chief Millington and numerous TPD officers, along with myself, Harder Chief of staff Ransom, TUSD Staff and trustees set up the stations with generous donations from the community. It was truly a Day of Action with various clothing, warming, hygiene, and nutrient needs including a hot lunch.
- Toured with Lauraine Fogarty of Serenity House in Tracy (1/19/2022) to learn more about the program that services those recovering from addiction.
- Attended North School Site Council Meeting for their Safety Plan Meeting (1/19/2022). Was honored to share how the City partners with TUSD and support their programs. I also shared my personal involvement with the Student Discovery Programs, BSUs, and other programs throughout the year as my children grew up in TUSD. I also provided the As to Q&A for almost an hour with numerous concerns about Homelessness and other topics.
- Participated in the Pre-Rally for the Point In Time Count for Tracy (1/27/2022). We had between 80-90 volunteers on the ground who went out to meet and locate the unsheltered and to find out their needs so we can best plan for programming. The PIT count also helps with funding and grants.

Tracy Bike Park Proposal Packet

Proposal: To refurbish one or more of the 85 City of Tracy Parks to accommodate a Pump Track, with future expansions to include BMX competition opportunities.

Potential Target Parks: Hoyt, Kenner, Clyde Bland or Zanussi Parks, or any City or Neighborhood Park that can accommodate a minimum ½ acre pump track design .

Why a Bike Park / Pump Park: Bike Parks provide family-friendly recreation and the need for safe, sustainable riding areas for the growing popularity of biking. A pump track is a circuit of rollers, banked turns, and features designed to be ridden completely by riders “pumping”- generating momentum by up and down body movements instead of pedaling and pushing. (Wikipedia)

Competitive Freestyle Biking has recently been included in the Olympic Games, recognizing a popular trending sport for all age and skill levels. Cities that promote bike facilities, with opportunities to advance in freestyle activities, are rapidly becoming destination areas for the biking community.

Design: All good pump tracks flow, and can be negotiated without pedaling or braking. The better tracks also feature opportunities for creative interpretation, with new line options opening up as riders progress in their skills.

Construction: There are various Construction Companies that specialize in the design and construction of Bike Park Facilities.

Dirt vs Asphalt Surface :

Dirt will be significantly less expensive, but will have the major pitfall of being beaten by the elements (maintenance costs equal to the upfront costs with asphalt quickly-depending on use), unless a soil stabilizer is used like enviro tech II to mitigate erosion, but must be applied when track gets maintained every so often depending on use 8-12 months. Asphalt surface allows for more than just cyclists to enjoy the track. Skateboarders, Scooters, etc, can make use of the track once properly paved creating a multi-use facility. (makes for a more family friendly environment that allows the smallest of riders to scoot along on their push bikes) + it looks a lot nicer too!

Protection from weather:

To ensure the park can get year-round use, it is strongly recommended to incorporate wind protection along the perimeter or build the track below ground level. Heat will also be a major threat to summer use if we do not consider shade/misters to keep riders cool. The best defense to protecting track surface and reducing maintenance costs is paving it with asphalt and lining any breaks in the asphalt with turf. While not in question, the best way to ensure year-round use is to utilize an abandoned warehouse.

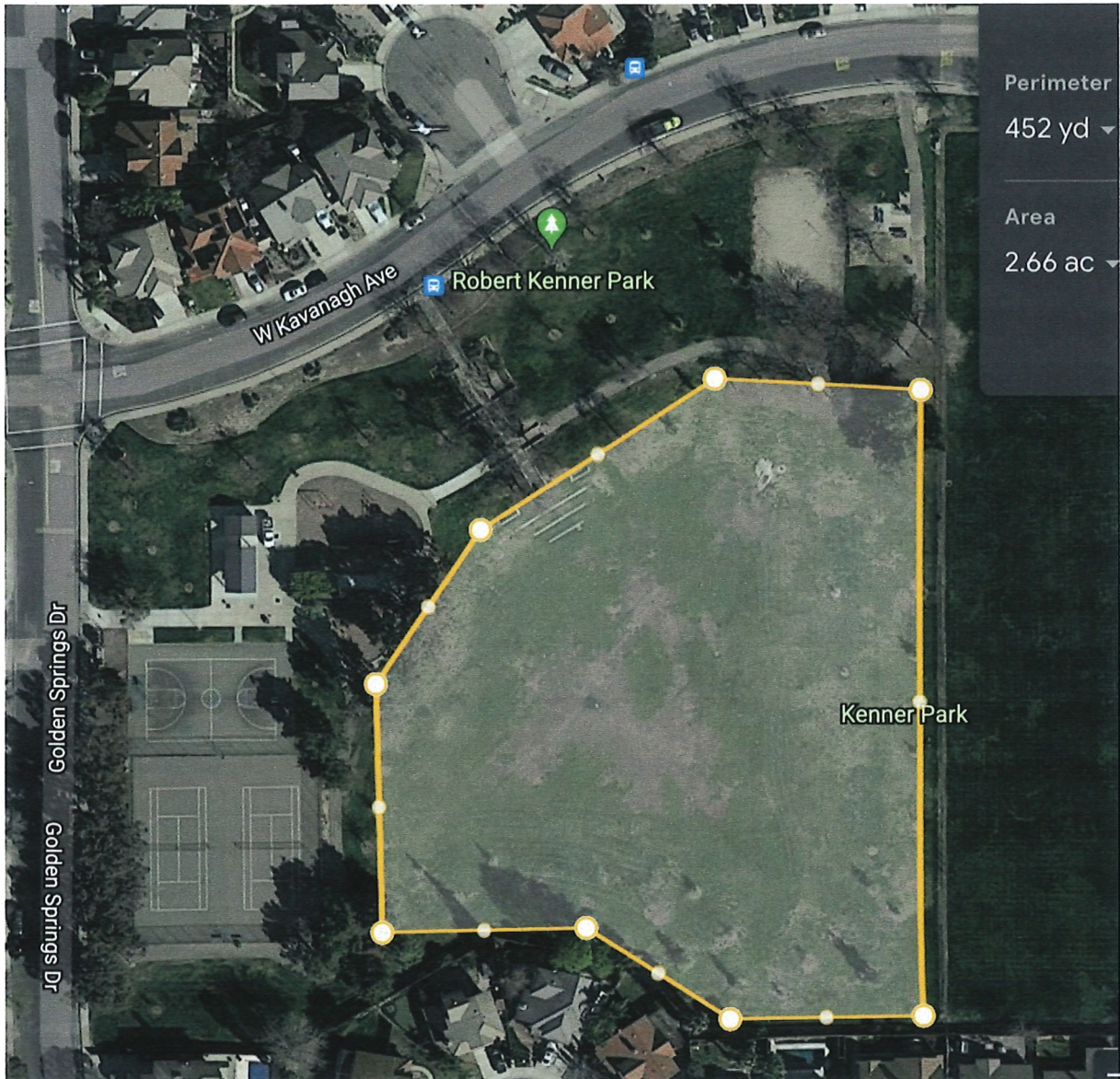
