Good evening mayor, council members,

I'm writing to you in regards to the request by developers of the Westside project, asking the city to revise the land use designation for parts of the Westside property to allow warehouse activities on the Westside property which is located south of 11th St. and west of Lammers, directly across from Kimball High School. I don't believe the community is in favor of warehouses and their attendant truck traffic on 11th & Lammers, across from a high school and the first thing visitors see when they arrive in Tracy from the 11th St 205 exit.

The developers conducted a public input meeting and an opinion survey which focused on two alternative land use options. One is Business Park Industrial and the other Residential. The developer's consultants asked meeting and survey participants to choose between these two alternatives, neither of which were preferred by a majority, but the Industrial land use option allowing warehouses is preferred by the developer.

Digging into the consultant report, you'll find that positive ratings for other land use options were given by survey respondents as follows:

Public gathering places 75%

Main street retail 73%

Hospital/medical 73%

Business park industrial 51%

Large format distribution (warehouses) 26%

The various residential land use options (single family, condo, etc.) received between 20% and 29% positive ratings.

In short, the community would like to see retail, gathering places, medical and business park industrial but no residential and no warehouses in this area of town.
