EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

City staff requests that the City Manager accept the construction contract for the Slurry Seal Project FY 20-21, CIP 73182 as complete. Project costs are within the available budget. Staff recommends the City Manager to accept the project to enable the City Engineer to release the contractor's bonds and retention payment.

DISCUSSION

On July 9, 2021, City Manager approved an award of construction project to American Asphalt Repair & Resurfacing Co, Inc. of Hayward, California to build the Slurry Seal Project FY 20-21, CIP 73182.

The scope of the project included pavement repair, slurry sealing, signage and striping on the following various neighborhoods: Sienna Park Drive, Amberwood Way, Monument Drive, Allegheny Street, and Shelborne Drive. The work also included pavement repair, slurry sealing, curb ramps, signage and striping for Mt. Diablo Avenue between Tracy Boulevard and C Street.

Engineering staff prepared the plans and specifications and advertised the Project for competitive bids on May 21st and May 28th, 2021. Bids for this Project were publicly opened on June 22, 2021. One change order was issued for unforeseen work.

Contractor has completed all the work required to be done in accordance with the plans and specifications, and has requested acceptance of the project. The City Engineer has inspected the completed work and confirmed that all work conform to the contract plans and specifications .

Final project costs were within budget as follows:

The Slurry Seal Project FY 20-21, CIP 73182 is an approved Capital Improvement Project with a total Project cost of \$501,252. The total project budget is \$700,000, and came in under budget, the remaining funds in the amount of \$198,748 will be released back into the Measure K Fund (F242).

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Manager Pursuant to Urgency Ordinance No. 1285, approve and accept the construction of the Slurry Seal Project FY 20-21 that American Asphalt Repair & Resurfacing Co, Inc., of Hayward California, CIP 73182. Authorize the City Clerk to record the Notice of Completion with the San Joaquin County Recorder, authorize the City Engineer to release the bond and retention payment in accordance with the contract documents and authorize the Finance Department to Close the Project.
