TRACER Ridership: A year-to-date comparison of current ridership compared to the same period in the previous year is shown below. Fixed route ridership is up 1,867 riders compared to the year-to-date ridership in August FY21/22, an increase of approximately 16%. Paratransit ridership is up 579 riders compared to the same time in August FY21/22, an increase of approximately 33%. Overall the Tracer system ridership has increased by 2,446 riders over the same period last year, an overall increase of approximately 18%
