Subject: Bikeways Update Implementation

---

The City of Tracy's Transit Division is currently working on a few items pertaining to bikeways throughout the City. Below is a list of those items and projected implementation timeline.

### **Updated Bikeways Map**

Staff are currently working on creating an updated map of the various bikeways that exist throughout the City. On one side will be the map and the reverse side will include pertinent information about items such as bike lane classifications, bicycle parking, rules of the road, areas of interest, etc. A digital map is scheduled to be completed by the end of October with printed copies available for distribution in late November.

### **Bike Rack Refresh**

As stated in a previous memo to Council, various bike racks in the downtown area have been freshly painted with a bright green color matching the green color now used for Class II bike paths on the roads. Staff will be expanding this color update to the bike racks located in the various parks throughout the City as well as some of the City facilities. This painting is scheduled to be completed by the end of November.

In addition to the painting, decals will be applied to the bike racks to help identify them as such. These decals are currently being created and will be applied to the existing bike racks already painted by the end of October. Additional bike racks will receive the decals as they are painted.

### **Additional Downtown Bike Racks**

Staff are currently identifying potential locations to place additional bike racks in the downtown area to allow for more bike parking closer to businesses. Once potential locations are identified, staff will work with TCCA in suggesting custom bike racks to be installed that represent the downtown area. It is anticipated that the locations and designs of the bike racks will be decided by

the end of October. An order for the new bike racks will then be placed and they will be installed when delivered, which will likely be sometime in January 2023.

**Bikeways Signage**

Staff have been reviewing the bikeways signage throughout the City and are currently compiling a list of areas where additional signage is needed or where the signs need to be replaced. This review will be complete by the end of October and new signs will be ordered and installed by the end of November.
