- Subject: Council Follow Up for 4th of July Planning 2023 Events, Parade, and Fireworks

In 2022, there were a number of changes that occurred with the annual 4th of July events in Tracy, including the discontinuation of the 4th of July Event in the Park hosted by the Tracy Chamber of Commerce (Chamber), the transition of hosting the 4th of July Parade from Chamber to the Tracy City Center Association (TCCA) with a changed parade route and relocating fireworks from the old Heinz Factory on Eleventh Street to Kimball High School (with fireworks still being hosted by the Chamber). Through these changes in 2022, the Chamber continued to host the annual Lions Pancake Breakfast at Lincoln Park.

At the City Council Meeting on July 5, 2022, Council Member Bedolla moved and was seconded by Council Member Davis, to connect all stakeholders involved with the July 4 activities to start planning for July 4, 2023, as soon as possible. On July 14, 2022, City Staff met with TCCA and Chamber to discuss the 2022 4th of July events and challenges that took place in 2022. At this meeting, Parks & Recreation Director Brian MacDonald informed both TCCA and Chamber that he intended to pursue a Request for Proposals (RFP) for 2023 to host the 4th of July events, parade, and fireworks show.

City Staff is currently working on an RFP to allow for any parties interested, to submit to host:

- 2023 4th of July Fireworks Display
- 2023 4th of July Drone Light Show, Laser Light Show or similar aerial show
- 2023 4th of July Parade
- Host a combination of either Fireworks Display, Light Show, or comparable aerial show, and/or Parade, or similar 4th of July Event.

This RFP was published on October 25, 2022 (<u>https://www.cityoftracy.org/government/rfp-notices</u>). City Staff will review all completed submissions and will continue the planning of 2023 4th of July events.
