Subject: Bill Schwartz Park - Hockey Rink Surfacing Renovation

Bill Schwartz Park is a 3.42-acre neighborhood park located in southwest Tracy near Corral Hollow Road and Peony Drive. The park amenities include 2-5 age and 5-12 age playground areas, a skate park, a shaded picnic area, a walking loop, an open lawn area, and a hockey rink. The hockey rink surfacing has reached its useful life and is need of renovation. A contractor has been procured through the informal bidding process to complete the surfacing renovation which includes new striping on the court. This work is planned to start on Friday, November 4th and be completed by November 11th pending weather and any unforeseen conditions. Staff will also be addressing some other minor maintenance items associated with the hockey rink in coordination with the resurfacing work.

Tracy Skates is a 150-member group that heavily utilizes this park amenity. As you may recall, this group reached out to Council with concerns about the existing condition of the surface. Our Parks Planning and Development division reached out to them to let them know of the renovation and we received great feedback and support from 12 of the members.
