

TRACY CITY COUNCIL - SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

January 9, 2023, 4:30 p.m.

Tracy City Hall, 333 Civic Center Plaza, Tracy, CA.

Mayor Young called the meeting to order at 4:37 p.m.

Roll Call found Council Members Arriola, Bedolla, Evans (virtually) and Mayor Young present. Mayor Pro Tem Davis was also in attendance virtually but unable to respond to roll call due to technical issues.

1. ITEMS FROM THE AUDIENCE – There were no items from the audience.

2. REGULAR ITEMS

2.A STAFF RECOMMENDS THAT CITY COUNCIL RATIFY THE PROCLAMATION CONFIRMING THE EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY RELATED TO THE SEVERE WINTER STORM.

Karin Schnaider, Assistant City Manager provided the staff report and responded to questions.

Council Member Evans thanked first responders who are on the scene as quickly as possible and recommended people stay home or if it is critical, check road conditions, replace wiper blades and check tires and bring water and warm clothes and be prepared for delays.

Council Member Arriola thanked staff for their hard work especially those on scene and pushing information on social media and website to communicate information to the public and wished everyone to be safe out there.

Mayor Young thanked all emergency responders and public works that are out there hands on right now and suggested taking time out there, do not be in a hurry and prepare your homes as well.

Karin Schnaider, Assistant City Manager gave gratitude to the operations and safety teams, there is a lot going on behind the scenes and wanted to acknowledge all their hard work. Ms. Schnaider stated without them she would not be able to do her job.

Staff is here to take any calls or any emergency information and are working and prioritizing those calls.
