DISCUSSION

Tracy Arts Month is an annual celebration of creativity and culture organized by the Cultural Arts Division in the City of Tracy. A series of public events featuring artists and arts organizations from the across the local area is promoted and presented across the month of April.

The Tracy Arts Commission (TAC) has approved participation in Downtown Tracy Arts Month in April, 2023, with a budget of \$2,000 supporting three performing arts-themed workshops in any of the following: acting/performance, improv, audition skills, independent filmmaking, costumes, props and cosplay. With continued discussion the TAC has agreed to focus the educational events on audition skills & reel development, spfx make-up and independent filmmaking.

The TAC began discussion in December, 2022 and will continue as needed in order to identify instructors/presenters and determine the programming details. Promotions for Tracy Arts Month are expected to begin in March.

FISCAL IMPACT

Appropriation of Tracy Arts Commission funding in the Cultural Arts Division budget in the amount of \$2,000 has been approved for programming components.

DISCUSSION

The Tracy Arts Commission (TAC) presented its first Annual Report to the City Council in February, 2022. This inaugural report provided an overview of programming for 2019, 2020 and 2021, as well as projected goals for FY2021-22. Originally the TAC intended to present the 2021 Annual Report in-person at the City Council meeting, however the presentation was modified as the meeting was moved to remote viewing and participation due to COVID-19 safety protocols.

The TAC may invite programming collaborators to be acknowledge during the presentation.

2022 Annual Report content has been identified and created through TAC discussion in October, November and December, 2022, and was approved at the meeting of January 10, 2023. Discussion will continue as needed in preparation for the presentation, and to address the outcomes.
