Q: How do I register?

A: Registration forms are available at www.RecycleInsideTheTriangle.com or by calling (209) 831-6300.

Q: How do I submit my registration form?

A: Completed forms can be emailed to garagesale@cityoftracy.org, faxed to (209) 831-4472, or mailed to: City of Tracy, Operations & Utilities Department, ATTN: Garage Sale, 520 Tracy Blvd., Tracy, CA 95376.

Q: What is the deadline to submit a registration form?

A: The deadline to submit a registration form is **April 14, 2023**.

Q: What are the benefits of registering my sale?

A: All registered sales will receive **FREE** advertising in the Tracy Press and on social media. Plus, your sale will be featured on a dot map available to shoppers both on-line and at coffee shops throughout the City.

Q: Can I post garage sale signs throughout town?

A: No. Signs are not permitted per Tracy Municipal Code 10.08.4510. The City advertises the event for you in the local newspaper, downtown businesses, and various social media sites. Posting on your own social media sites is also a great way to let people know you are having a garage sale. Posting signs can create safety hazards for drivers and creates blight in our community. Please do not post signs. It takes a lot of staff resources to clear the illegally posted signs. Thank you.

Q: How long is the garage sale?

A: Garage Sale participants are asked to hold their sales from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. If you are a buyer, we recommend shopping before Noon for the best buys.

Q: How will I locate the garage sales?

A: A Garage Sale Map with a list of addresses and merchandise will be available no later than April 25, 2023 on our website www.RecycleInsideTheTriangle.com and at the following locations: City Hall, Tracy Library, Boyd Service Center, Chamber of Commerce, and local businesses.

Q: What can I do with the unsold items left over from my garage sale?

A: Pack them up and save them for another sale or donate them. There are many charitable organizations that would be happy to accept your gently used items. Generally speaking, most donations are tax-deductible.
