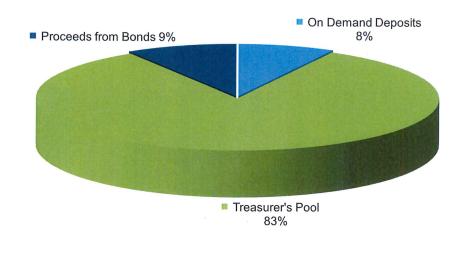

# City of Tracy - Investment Summary January 31, 2023 \$481,666,024.25 Market Value



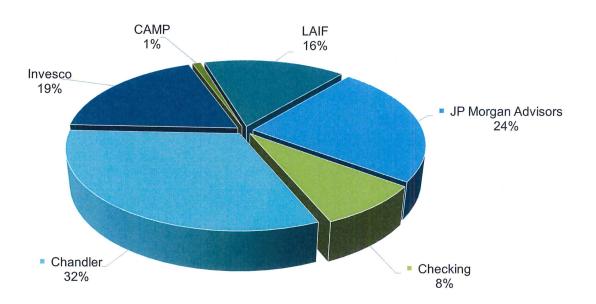
