



Segment 1: Grant Line Road to Lowell Avenue:


- Pavement Improvement
- Accessibility

- Addition of Bike Routes



W Lowell Ave to W 11th St**




IMPROVEMENTS: PAVEMENT

- Rehabilitation of road pavement
- Adding and improving on-street parking along both sides of Bessie Ave from Grant Line Rd to Lowell Ave
- New and refreshed centerline striping and pavement markings




UTILITIES IMPROVEMENTS

- Storm Drain System
- Water System
- Sanitary Sewer System



IMPROVEMENTS STORM DRAIN



To reduce localized flooding and improve storm drain capacities along Bessie Ave, the project will include:

- 1,677 LF of new storm drain pipes
- 21 new drop-inlets
- 16 new storm drain manholes



IMPROVEMENTS: WATER AND SEWER

Water System:

- 2,627 LF of new 8" water main
- Installation of 8" water valves
- Replacement and installation of 5 fire hydrants.

Sanitary Sewer System:

- Installation, resizing, upgrade, and relocation of a 12" SS (1,866 LF)
- Replacement of the 4" SS Residential line
- Replacement of the 6" Commercial Line
- A new sewer manhole


IMPROVEMENTS

SAFETY MEASURES

The project also includes:

- The upgrade and installation of accessible concrete sidewalks
- Installation of 22 new ADA ramps
- Improvements to 14 driveway road access
- Installation of 20 new streetlights to increase road visibility and create a walking-friendly street.
- Improved safety and access to the Ritter Family Ball Park through the installation of new high-visibility crosswalks at 21st St and 23rd St.
- Installed new shared Class III bike routes to encourage outdoor activities.

PROJECT IMPACTS

The primary objective is to ensure the safety and timely completion of these improvements.

Summer 2023 – Spring 2024

To accomplish this goal the project will include the following impacts on the surrounding community:

- Phased Roadway Closures
- Minimized Access to Ritter Family Ball Park
- Temporary Utility Shutdowns

ROAD CLOSURES



- Temporary Road closures to occur in phases for through traffic.
- Emergency Vehicles will have access during closures
- Access will be granted for Local traffic only
- Contractor to set plates over trenched areas outside construction hours for safety
- Traffic Control Plan with Detours is under development. More info will be followed.




ROAD CLOSURES

SAFETY FIRST

RITTER FAMILY BALL PARK



Ritter Family Ball Park will remain open during construction.

The following measures will be in place to ensure the safety of residents:

- The Bessie Ave Entrance to the park will be closed during construction
- Barricades to be placed along Bessie Ave to safely separate the park from the construction area
- Primary access to the park and the north parking lot will be available through the Tracy Blvd entrance.

SAFETY FIRST



TEMPORARY UTILITY SHUTDOWNS

Residents and Businesses within the construction area may temporarily lose access to Water and Sewer Utilities.

Shut Down Notice will be given 72 hours in advance through Door Hangers and/or Door-to-Door Notifications

The Contractor and City of Tracy representatives will NOT ask to enter your residence or private property.
