1. **CALL TO ORDER:** Chair Cooper called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

3. **ITEMS FROM THE AUDIENCE:** Alice English, Tracy resident, congratulated on a successful event at the Tracy Airport and commented on the staff and Commission working as a team on hosting the International Aerobatic Competition (IAC) at Tracy Airport. Ms. English requested the public and Commission to attend the June 20th Council Meeting to comment on the agenda item regarding the Aquatic Center.
Joe Curtis, Administrator of St. Bernard's Catholic School, addressed concerns regarding the traffic congestion on Eaton Ave. between Parker Ave. and Holly Ave. during the school bell time of Central School and St. Bernard School since Central School relocated their entrance to Eaton Ave from Parker Ave. He suggested ways to mitigate the current congestion and requested that City act immediately to prevent fatal accidents. Patricia Paredes, Principal of St. Bernard's Catholic School, also raised safety concerns and commented on the increased traffic congestion since relocating the Central School entrance to Eaton Ave across from St. Bernard's School.

The motion by Commissioner R. Dhillon to nominate Commissioner Cooper as Chair was seconded by Commissioner Francis and approved by the majority. Motion by Commissioner R. Dhillon to nominate Commissioner Silva as Vice Chair was second by Commissioner Cooper and approved by the majority.
 - b. **Receive Presentation on Temporary Traffic Signal Operation and the Status of a Permanent Signal at Valpico Road and Corral Hollow Road:** Koosun Kim City Engineer / Assistant Director of Development Services presented an Update on the Corral Hollow/Valpico Road Intersection Temporary Traffic Signal Operation, including current operations, key event timeline, and traffic patterns from Dec 22 to May 23. Commission questions and comments followed.
Alice English, Tracy, addressed her concerns about the number of accidents at the site and suggested installing back the stop sign before the school reopens, a safer option than the current unsafe traffic lights that have progressed worse.

Staff provided information on various City events for Commission outreach. Provided information on the Short-Range Transit Plan (SRTP) and TRACER Fare policy. Staff responded to the Commission on the Transit Station Ribbon Cutting Ceremony.

Thanked Dave Watson for bringing the event to Tracy and the pilots from around the world who competed. Recognized City Departments and staff for making the event a success. Commissioner Francis: Shared his experience attending first time the Aerobatic Competition. He enjoyed the event but not the ride on the road to the airport.

Commissioner Cooper: Expressed that he enjoyed the Aerobatic event at Tracy Airport.
