AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TRACY, CALIFORNIA,  
REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 501  
RELATING TO THE TRACY COMMUNITY

WHEREAS, the City wishes to repeal Ordinance No. 501 and establish the Tracy Community Cultural Arts Commission by resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of Tracy hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: Ordinance 501 establishing the Tracy Community Cultural Arts Commission is hereby repealed.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its final passage and adoption.
