DISCUSSION

At the November 8, 2023 City Council meeting, the City of Tracy's City Council awarded a contract with CHS Consulting (CHS) to provide an updated Short Range Transit Plan (SRTP). As part of the SRTP update, a public survey was conducted in May and June of 2024, and a public outreach meeting was held on August 17, 2024.

Based on the survey results, and feedback from the public outreach meeting, a series of proposed changes to the TRACER transit system have been developed for consideration.

The proposed changes were be presented by CHS to the commission during the September 12, 2024 regular meeting for feedback prior to finalization. A final recommendation of the proposed changes will be presented by CHS to the commission during the October 10, 2024 regular meeting. The tentative schedule for final approval of the SRTP is as follows:

- September 12, 2024 Transportation Advisory Commission (TAC) input on draft recommendations - COMPLETE
- October 10, 2024 TAC presentation of final recommendations
- December 3, 2024 City Council approval of SRTP

TRACER Ridership: A year-to-date comparison of current ridership compared to the same period in the previous year is shown below. Fixed route ridership is up 1,817 riders compared to the year-to-date ridership in August FY 23/24, an increase of approximately 10%. Paratransit ridership is up 1,294 riders compared to the same time in August FY 23/24, an increase of approximately 42%. Overall, the Tracer system ridership has increased by 3,111 over the same period last year, an overall increase of approximately 14%.
