3rd Quarter Benchmark Year









Population is Leaving the Bay Area...


Bay Area Population Change





San Joaquin County Population Change





Bay Area home prices 3x NSJV




Truck trips converge in Oakland and NSJV





Tracy's Economy: Quick Facts


- Tracy is the 9th fastest growing city in Northern California by population
- In 2000, Tracy's population was 57,000
- In 2016, Tracy's population was 90,000
- Median Home Price: \$439,700
- 3,500 housing units approved/under construction (+13% growth)





Tracy Employment by Industry, 2016




Inland Growth in Tech and Healthcare Jobs

Oakland-Hayward-Berkeley Employment by Industry, 2016




Average Weekly Wages by County, 2016 MANUFACTURING

Median Household Income Growth








Truck Traffic Contributes to Heavy Congestion



ACE Ridership Grows, but Reaches Peak?


Megaregional Passenger Rail Ridership 2007-2014




