**GROWTH MANAGEMENT BOARD DETERMINATION OF ALLOCATION OF RESIDENTIAL GROWTH ALLOTMENTS FOR USE IN CALENDAR YEAR 2013**

DISCUSSION

This is a meeting of the Growth Management Board (GMB), and a public hearing to determine if the applicant qualifies for allocation of new Residential Growth Allotments (RGAs) and possible allocation of RGAs.

On October 16, 2012, the City Council adopted revisions to the Growth Management Ordinance (GMO) Guidelines. Included in these revisions is a provision that applications for RGAs can be filed at any time in calendar years 2013 and 2014, and that the Growth Management Board (GMB) will meet as needed in response to any applications received. Three applications have been submitted for RGAs thus far in 2013, but only one can be considered at this time, because the other two are ineligible because they are not yet approved (per Section C.2 of the GMO Guidelines, Application and Eligibility Requirements). Both of these projects are actively working toward project approvals, but will not be eligible to receive an allocation of RGAs until their projects are approved. The project qualified to receive an allocation of RGAs is summarized below.

Priority Area Project

The City received one application for RGAs within the Priority Area that is eligible to receive RGAs.

**RGA13-0001 – Sierra Hills Development, LLC – Tracy Sierra Apartments – 300 RGAs**

The project is located at the northeast corner of Pavilion Parkway and Power Road, and will be constructed with 300 apartment units within seven buildings, a pool and clubhouse, and various parking and landscape improvements (Attachment A).

The City Council approved the apartment project on February 19, 2013 and Sierra Hills Development submitted an application for RGAs on March 1, 2013.

Staff recommends that the Growth Management Board allocate 300 RGAs to the Tracy Sierra Apartments project, in compliance with the GMO Guidelines.
