Septic Hauler Wastewater Discharge Permit Part A – Application

A septic tank discharge permit is mandatory for any vehicle discharging septic waste to Tracy Waste Water Treatment Facility. Only septic waste is allowed to be discharged and hazardous contaminants (explosive, infectious, toxic, flammable, corrosive, etc.). A comple and valid permit must be on file along with no unpaid fees from any past billings. Part B – Basic Permit Requirements/Reminders

B1. a. A \$500 deposit is required with the City of Tracy Finance Department before dumping can begin.

- b. Spills caused by truck drivers will be assessed a minimum of \$25 for City personnel labor costs, for clean-up.
- c. Trucks are required to carry and use 90 degree elbow fittings while dumping at the P.O.T.W.
- d. Septic waste loads may be discharged on Mondays Fridays between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.


B2. Hazardous Substances:

It is strictly forbidden to discharge any hazardous/toxic substances to Tracy's Waste Treatment Plant.

It is the responsibility of the Septic Tank Hauler that its wastes are free from dangerous, toxic, hazardous, explosive and infectious substances.

- B3. Septic tank haulers who operate within the City of Tracy must display a current City business license in his vehicle. A City license is not required for haulers working outside City limits, in San Joaquin County.
- B4. Each driver, before discharging, will report to the wastewater treatment plant office and supply all of the information required on a septic waste dischargers report.
- B5. Each driver, before discharging, may be subject to having his waste sampled, visually inspected, and analyzed by a laboratory as required by the Utilities Division staff.
- B6. Each permittee will be required to pay \$66.90 per 1,000 gallons discharged on a monthly basis, to be billed based on information filed on septic wastes dischargers reports. Billing criteria may be subject to change based on annual revenue requirements and without prior notice.
- B7. The permittee shall report to the City of Tracy Utilities Director any information that deviates from that supplied in its original application.
- B8. Failure to comply with any of the regulations outlined in this septic tank truck permit can result in cancellation of permit and possible fines. This permit may be revoked upon termination of permission to discharge by the San Joaquin Local Health District.

B9. Septic tank waste water is accepted only from the recognized service area, except by special agreement with the City of Tracy (full sized map included with permit).
