



AB 341 MANDATORY BUSINESS RECYCLING

Don't forget laws have changed, make sure your business is in compliance. The State of California have passed bills regarding commercial and multi-family recycling regulations, Assembly Bill 32 (California Global Warming Solutions Act of 2006) and Assembly Bill 341. The purpose of these laws are to reduce greenhouse gas emissions (use less natural resources and reduce emissions by manufacturing products from recycled materials) in the State by diverting commercial solid waste through recycling programs. All businesses that generate 4 cubic yards of refuse or more per week are required to have a recycling program in place to be in compliance with State regulations. All multi-family complexes of 5 units or more are also required to have a recycling program in place.
