## FAQS:

**Q: I just moved to Tracy; how do I start garbage service?**

A: If you live within the City of Tracy, call (209)831-6800.

**Q: How do I order a dumpster?**

A: Contact Tracy Disposal Service at (209)835-0601 for sizes, prices and delivery information.

**Q: Where is the nearest dump?**

A: The Tracy Material Recovery & Solid Waste Transfer Station is located at 30703 S. MacArthur Dr. in Tracy. For information, directions and pricing, visit [www.tracymaterialrecovery.com](http://www.tracymaterialrecovery.com) or call (209)832-2355.

**Q: I have more garbage than will fit in my car. What do I do?**

A: For an extra pick up of your car, or to have extra garbage picked up on your garbage day, call (209)835-0601. Extra garbage must be bagged, bundled or boxed and must be scheduled prior to your pick up day. There is a small fee for this service. \*Extras that have not been scheduled in advance will not be collected.
