

Recycle Hazardous Material



The City of Tracy in partnership with San Joaquin County offers a free Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Collection Event in Tracy annually, providing we have the budget. San Joaquin County residents can take their HHW year round Thursday - Saturday from 9am - 3pm at 7850 R.A. Bridgeford Street, Stockton, CA, free of charge.

San Joaquin County residents can dispose of household hazardous waste in and around their homes, as well as unwanted electronics (E-Waste) and universal waste (U-Waste) at these events or at the HHW facility.

HHW products are usually marked with caution/warning labels and contain hazardous chemicals that may be toxic, flammable, corrosive or reactive. It is illegal to dispose of these items in the garbage, down drains, or onto the ground because they contain dangerous materials that threaten human health and the environment.

In addition to HHW, it is also illegal for consumers to dispose of unwanted electronics and universal waste in the garbage. Typical E-Waste and U-Waste items found in households may contain toxic or corrosive materials which can also pose a threat to the environment and our health. These items will also be collected FREE of charge.
