a. Discuss the status of the 2017 Youth Advisory Commission's goals and work plan

Commissioner J. Dhillion provided an update on the Intergenerational event at the Lolly Hansen Senior Center and mentioned that attending the event is a good experience that benefits both teens and seniors. Commissioner J. Dhillion also provided an update for the SAT/ACT Prep Course subcommittee and mentioned that hosting a workshop that offered exam type conditions with online preparations and testing, similar to the Tracy Library courses, was discussed rather than finding a contractor to teach a course. Staff Geibig surveyed the Commission on the idea to find a contractor to teach a SAT/ACT Prep Course or to host test prep classes. Commissioner Collins mentioned that he took a similar course at the Tracy Library and thought that it was effective. Commissioner Gadamsetti mentioned a free online resource that provides test taking skills. The community service project subcommittee provided an update on the research they have done and Commissioner Razi mentioned opportunities working with both Tracy Interfaith and the Tracy Library. Commissioner R. Dhillion mentioned that she researched the Tracy Animal Shelter and the McHenry House. Staff Jensen sent a flyer to all Commissioners to recruit teen participation for the Park Clean-Up event on April 22, 2017. Staff Geibig asked the Commission to add the event to the school bulletin, post to their social media accounts and post flyers in classrooms.

b. Provide an update on the summer teen camp programs and marketing strategy

Commissioner Cho listed all of the teen camp programs that would be available to volunteer for this summer. Each Commissioner was then given the opportunity to select two camps that they would like to volunteer for. A subcommittee meeting was scheduled for May 5, 2017 to discuss further marketing strategies.
