- ADA access to FBO building
- Install parking meters (high density areas, potential revenue opportunity)
- Relocate train at Dr. Powers Park to Downtown Tracy, provide train shelter.
- Sidewalk on MacArthur North of Schulte

- Improve bike lane visibility
- Bike lane rehab
- Install more charging stations (Library, City Hall, etc.)
- Install bathrooms, South side Tracy Airport
- Structural upgrades to the hangars
- Water access on both sides of airport
- Convert City fleet to alternate fuel
- Sprinklers in existing hangars
- Upgrade Tracy Blvd., south of Linne Road
- AWOS II
