Airport Updates: Ed Lovell referred the Commission to airport updates, provided information on the grant application for the reconstruction of the general aviation apron area. Commissioner Gamino enquired about a solar project at the airport, staff informed there is none.

Transit Updates: Transit Update on Year to Date Ridership for March was at 111,831 down 7,290 riders compared to Year to Date Ridership in March FY14-15, a decrease of approximately 6%. Staff provided updates on RTD Bart Commuter routes providing service at the Tracy Transit Station starting May 23, 2016.

Commissioner Silva: encouraged new TRACER fleets to have advertisement features. Commissioner Vaughn: addressed his concerns regarding air condition on the buses not working properly.

Commissioner Krogh: asked how the bus routes are monitored for time performance. Commissioner Gamino: commented on bus and taxi operators license and appeal process.
