3. ITEMS FROM THE AUDIENCE: Andrew Lees, Tracy, interested in knowing about City's plan on having bike pathway alongside the existing railroads.

5. OLD BUSINESS:

a. Provide Updates on Commission Goals and Objectives for FY 2017/18: Currently no updates until spring 2018.

6. NEW BUSINESS:

a. Provide Input on Potential Projects to consider for Submission of the Measure K Bicycle, Pedestrian & Safe Routes to School and Smart Growth incentive Program: Staff provided update on SJCOG's Measure K funding, \$19 million, available for San Joaquin County bikeway projects. Staff encouraged Commission and subcommittee to address all the bikeway improvement items. Commission discussed upgrades for existing bike pathways and areas, especially schools that could tremendously benefit from having new bike pathways. Commission and audience commented on connecting the hole in the bikeway system and providing this community a safe bikeway system. Staff will be meeting with City Engineering Dept. with Commission recommended list. Commission requested Staff to provide a report after consulting with the Engineering Dept.

Commission also addressed streets that require proper sidewalks and crosswalks for public, and suggested crossing signals and cameras to be installed for the safety of the public.

Andrew Lees, Tracy, addressed intersections with limited access to pedestrians due to dirt pathways. He also recommended police enforcement at Mountain House Parkway, due to unsafe activities.

7. ITEMS FROM THE COMMISSION:

<u>Commissioner Silva</u>: addressed his discontent regarding the on time performance of TRACER Fixed Route bus service. He commented it is a disservice to public, suggested City revisits the measures in place with the Contractor. He is disappointed the on time performance has not improved since the new contract.

<u>Commissioner Gamino</u>: Commented on Public Transportation and how this City is concerned about more growth Instead of supporting and preserving the open space and prevent urban sprawl much as possible.

8. ITEMS FROM STAFF

- a. Airport Updates: Ed Lovell provided updates on Tracy Airport construction project. The final signed document from the contractor for the Replacement of AWOS and PAPI project, was submitted to FAA and staff is awaiting a Notice to Proceed from the FAA. Commissioner English commented about the project taking too long. Staff explained the process and the FAA timeline on various items that prolonged the project. Commissioner Silva remarked on the project timeline. He thanked staff for keeping on top of the project. Commissioner English also enquired about the following; status regarding surplus buses stored at the airport, the FAA market value for storage at the airport and compensation on the water pipeline project at the airport. Staff informed the buses stored at the airport went to the Council to be approved as surplus and working with the FAA regarding the water pipe line.
- b. Transit Updates: Staff provided Transit updates and addressed Commissioner Silva's concerns regarding the poor on time performance. Staff responded there are multiple reasons and staff will continue assessing and addressing the issues to the contractor. Commissioner Vaughn asked for updates on new fareboxes and public access to real time bus info. Staff provided timeline on the farebox Wi-Fi installation to start in December. City has decided to replace the existing software RouteMatch with google base software that will provide an efficient real time bus status and on time performance status.
- c. Bikeway Updates: Commission will provide staff bikeway improvement items.

RECEIVE UPDATE ON APPLICATION SUBMISSION TO THE MEASURE K BICYCLE, PEDESTRIAN & SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL AND SMART GROWTH INCENTIVE PROGRAM

DISCUSSION

At the November 9, 2017 regular meeting of the Transportation Advisory Commission, the Commission was asked to provide input on projects that the City could submit applications for as part of the San Joaquin Council of Government's (SJCOG) Measure K Bicycle, Pedestrian & Safe Routes to School and Smart Growth Incentive Program call for projects. This was specific to a goal of the Commission to "Seek Bikeways Grant Opportunities."

The Commission provided the following suggestions on projects which the City could apply:

- Sidewalk/Bike path connection from Kimball High School to Redbridge
- Bike lane completion on Valpico Road between Raley's and Glenbriar
- Bike lane/path gap closures on major arterial roads (Corral Hollow, MacArthur, Grantline, Tracy Blvd, 11th Street)
- Pedestrian flashers at midblock crossings on Grantline Road

These suggestions were discussed with the Engineering Division along with other suggestions of potential projects from City staff. While there were many projects on the list, staff looked at all projects from the perspective of which ones would be able to best compete for the available funds. The City has decided to submit a total of 4 projects for this program as follows:

- Sidewalk/Bike path connection from Kimball High School to Redbridge
- Sidewalk connection on eastside of Tracy Blvd between Valpico and Whispering Wind
- Bike lane, curb, gutter, sidewalk on Central Avenue near Tracy Blvd
- Sidewalk on MacArthur Blvd between Schulte and 6th Street

The City is working with a consultant who is assisting with preparing the applications to submit to SJCOG. The deadline to submit the applications is December 15, 2017.

TRACER Ridership: A year to date comparison of current ridership compared to the same period in the previous year is shown below. Fixed route ridership is up 9,988 riders compared to year to date ridership in October FY16/17, an increase of approximately 12.7%. Paratransit ridership is up 291 riders compared to the same time in FY16/17, an increase of approximately. 11%. Overall the Tracer system ridership has increased by 10,279 riders over the same period last year, an overall increase of approximately 13%
