TRACER Ridership: A year to date comparison of current ridership compared to the same period in the previous year is shown below. Fixed route ridership is up 12,191 riders compared to year to date ridership in April FY16/17, an increase of approximately 11%. Paratransit ridership is up 1,811 riders compared to the same time in FY16/17, an increase of approximately 13%. Overall the Tracer system ridership has increased by 14,002 riders over the same period last year, an overall increase of approximately 11%
