<u>Transit Update</u> By Jayne Pramod

TRACER Ridership: A year to date comparison of current ridership compared to the same period in the previous year is shown below. Fixed route ridership is up 2,575 riders compared to year to date ridership in July FY17/18, an increase of approximately 28%. Paratransit ridership is up 2,144 riders compared to the same time in FY17/18, an increase of approximately 19%. Overall the Tracer system ridership has increased by 2,817 riders over the same period last year, an overall increase of approximately 27%
