<u>Transit Update</u> By Jayne Pramod

TRACER Ridership: A year to date comparison of current ridership compared to the same period in the previous year is shown below. Fixed route ridership is up 4,371 riders compared to year to date ridership in Septemebr FY17/18, an increase of approximately 13%. Paratransit ridership is down 82 riders compared to the same time in FY17/18, a decrease of approximately 2%. Overall the Tracer system ridership has increased by 4,289 riders over the same period last year, an overall increase of approximately 11%.
