TRACER Ridership: A year to date comparison of current ridership compared to the same period in the previous year is shown below. Fixed route ridership is down 2,557 riders compared to year to date ridership in August FY18/19, a decrease of approximately 9.6% Paratransit ridership is up by 960 riders compared to the same time in FY18/19, an increase of approximately 30.8%. Overall the Tracer system ridership has decreased 1,597 riders over the same period last year, an overall decrease of approximately 5.4%
