DISCUSSION

The City of Tracy is constructing a new animal shelter at 2375 Paradise Road after several years of development. This modular facility, designed in multiple phases to total approximately 12,000-square-feet, is anticipated to open as early as December. The initial phase of 5,638-square-feet is being completed at a cost of \$5,195,460.

In the summer of 2013, Cultural Arts Division Staff was invited to participate in a series of meetings with key members of the Tracy Animal Shelter Project Team. CAD Staff presented several design and civic art considerations in those meetings.

At the Special Meeting of November 18th, 2014, the Tracy Arts Commission requested Staff to provide an update on the project to facilitate a discussion regarding the design components and/or civic artworks that will be incorporated in the new facility, now and in future phases.
