## **DISCUSSION**

The Tracy Arts Commission reviewed and approved recommendations for upcoming 2017 programming at the September 2016 meeting. The Emerging Artists Series and the Music in the Park Series will return, with significant changes planned for the summer concerts. Commissioners have requested an on-going discussion item to refine the operational management of the recommendations, including budget and event dates.

## **Emerging Artists**

- Network with local performing arts groups and schools to increase participation
- Feature a different youth performer at each TAC event, as needed in 2017
- Performers will sing The National Anthem, and optional song at intermission

#### Music in the Park

- Continue concert series in June and July at Lincoln Park (and other locations) on select Thursdays at 7 pm, and at the Downtown Tracy Artwalk (Friday, August 11th)
- Feature professional and diverse local/regional musical acts
- Invite community visual and performing artists and organizations to participate
- Invite community organizations and business to participate
- Effectively network with surrounding neighborhood and beyond to increase audiences
- Effectively host events by increasing community engagement at concerts
- Add hospitality (food/beverages/cooling tent/seating) services and vendors
- Create commercial and non-profit marketing program with sponsorship opportunities
- Increase budget with funds previously used for the Tracy Arts & Cultural Festival

- Community Groups: Southside Community Organization, West Side Pioneers Association, Donna Baker Real Estate Agent
- Hospitality Vendor: Aldo's Gelato Cart

Thursday, July 27<sup>th</sup> - Dr. Powers Park at 7 pm

- Band: Country Band TBD
- Community Groups: Tracy Art League, Tracy Camera Club
- Hospitality Vendor: Kona Ice Truck

Friday, August 11<sup>th</sup> – Downtown Park Plaza (in collaboration with the Artwalk) at 6:30 pm

- Band: Central Latino AllStars
- Community Groups: Tracy Crimestoppers, Pujabi Cultural Society, Tracy Afghan Association, Mountain House Asian American Society, Tracy African American Association
- Hospitality Vendor: Kona Ice Truck (at 7<sup>th</sup> St.)

Commissioners agreed to communicate with and confirm community groups and hospitality vendors participation. CAM Wilson will communicate with the Tracy Art League and Tracy Camera Club, and will create a version of the event outline for Commissioner's use/reference.

Table and chairs sets, as well as water, will be provided to the invited community groups. The Commission decided it did not need to use tent space, but some groups will need to share space across the three tents.

CAM Wilson advised the Commission he was working on event permits, band scheduling, sound tech bids and the first wave of marketing.

The Special Events Subcommittee members provided the Commission with an update from the Emerging Artists auditions held on April 29<sup>th</sup> and May 6<sup>th</sup>. The Commission's effort to increase participation resulted in many more young performers auditioning. Staff will provide the score sheets to the Subcommittee so that they can schedule the performers accordingly.

#### 4. CONTINUE DISCUSSION OF NEW YOUTH PROGRAMMING FOR 2017-18

Commissioner Dhugga reported that she engaged in a presentation to the Youth Advisory Commission (YAC) on April 12<sup>th</sup>. Feedback from the conversation included:

- A positive reaction, excitement about the event idea, and fit to YAC mission
- YAC suggested they should select the performers
- Preferred date of event should be in April or May at the end of the school year
- Preferred time of event should be 4 to 7 pm after school
- A contest to name the festival in the schools
- Possible collaboration with school groups
- Liked the idea of a downtown location IE: Downtown Park Plaza
- Could be promoted by youth themselves through social media
- Student groups or artists could compete in categories

The YAC invited Commissioner Dhugga to return when additional details could be presented in order to determine YAC role in the event.
