2. DISCUSS ACTION PLAN FOR YOUTH PROGRAMMING RECOMMENDATIONS

Commissioners reviewed the preliminary overview of the project:

- A needed event in the community for middle and high school aged youth
- To include student organizations and participants from across the community and schools, representing visual and performing arts
- Event needs the support of teachers, student group advisors, and other community organizations committed to youth activities in Tracy
- Event to showcase youth talent that is appreciated by youth audiences
- A strolling event in downtown, after school at 5:00 p.m. on a Friday

Commissioners discussed the need to research similar events in the region, and considered the benefits of designing the event around a talent show, mainstage, and headlining performer such as a DJ. CAM Wilson suggested it could be beneficial to build such an event into the summer concert series, similar to how the Tracy Arts & Cultural Festival was developed and marketed.

Commissioners agreed to meet again on May 8 at 6:00 p.m. to continue discussion.
